

Dallas School District summer pool schedule

Dallas School District announces its summer pool schedule:

American Red Cross swim program classes open to the public will run June 9 to July 18. There will be three, two-week sessions. Classes will be from 1 to 3 p.m. Cost is \$45 per session.

All ages are welcome. A basic water test will be administered to determine level of instruction.

Levels of Instruction:

Level I: Water Exploration - beginning swimmers and toddlers - session 1 - June 9 to 20.

Level II: Primary Skills - session 1 - June 9 to 20.

Level III: Stroke Readiness - session 2 - June 23 to July 3 - No class July 4.

Level IV: Stroke Development - session 2 - June 23 to July 3 - No class July 4.

Level V: Stroke Refinement - session 3 - July 7 to July 18.

Level VI: Stroke Proficiency - session 3 - July 7 to July 18.

Level VII: Advanced Skills - session 3 - July 7 to July 18.

The Dallas Competitive Swimming and Diving Clinic will be held June 9 to July 18, Monday, Tuesday and Thursday.

It is open to all Dallas school students, kindergarten through 9th grade.

Cost is \$35 per student.

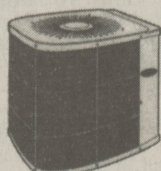
