pants will meet at the Center Street Park each morning. Children should bring a bag lunch and drink each day.

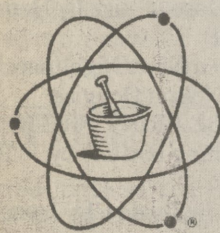
