From the Rainbow Room in New York to the West Coast, the famed Midiri Brothers bring their Benny Goodman tribute-themed performance to College Misericordia's outdoor First Union Amphitheatre on Monday evening, July 7, at 8 p.m., opening the annual Under the Stars Summer Arts Festival.

To say that their creative arrangements are in the tradition of the Swing and Dixie eras only begins to set the stage for what to expect from this 16-piece orchestra. The Midiri Brother twins, Joe and Paul, navigate the twisting tunes of fluid big band sound with powerful, high-throttle energy that ignites heartstrings with as authentic a sound, "as though Benny Goodman had come back to life!" Whether fast and frenzied, or mesmerizing and sultry, their focused, dynamic mastery of musicianship engages the spirit to flight with a beauty that can best be felt, not described. Jazz enthusiast and commentator Frank Nissel will be on hand to introduce the orchestra and to set the theme for this exciting evening.
