Opening day info for Dallas schools Dallas bus schedules

Dallas High School

Mr. Frank P. Galicki, Principal of the Dallas Senior High School, announces that the 2003-2004 school year will begin for all students in the Dallas School District on Tuesday, August 26. The first day of school is a full-day session. The professional staff of the Dallas Schools will participate in orientation programs on Monday, August 25.

The high school begins at 8 p.m. and dismisses at 2:58 p.m. Parents should consult the bus routes published in this newspaper to determine their child's bus assignment and departure points. Concerns about bus transportation should be addressed to Mrs. Susan Farr, Bus Coordinator, at the Dallas School District Administration Offices, Church Street, Dallas.

All Dallas Senior High School seniors, juniors and sophomores should consult the bulletin board listings in the cafeteria, and report to their assigned homerooms at 8 a.m. Dallas Senior High School freshmen should consult the bulletin board listings at the main office entrance and report to their assigned homerooms. Secondary students who have not registered for school should report to the building office of their respective schools.

The school lunch program will begin on August 26. Student lunches for senior high school students are a la carte.

Dallas Middle School

Mr. Anthony B. Martinelli, Principal, and his staff have been busy all summer readying the Dallas Middle School building and program for the opening classes on Tuesday, August 26.

Sixth, seventh, and eighth grade students should report to the middle school building between 7:45 and 8 a.m. Sixth grade students should report to the auditorium. Seventh grade students should report to the gymnasium. Eighth grade students should report to the cafeteria. A short orientation program including assignment to homerooms will be made. Students will then report to their homerooms in preparation for their first day of school.

Students will be able to purchase lunch beginning with the first day of school. The price of a regular lunch is \$1.60 and a reduced lunch is 40¢. Students

who participated in the free or reduced lunch program last year will begin the new year on the same status.

Dallas Elementary

For kindergarten to fifth grade students who attend the Dallas Elementary School, school will begin on Tuesday, August 26.

Students will be attending full day sessions from 9:10 a.m. to 3:40 p.m. parents should consult the bus routes published in this newspaper and from school the first day to facilitate student awareness of their bus assignment and to aid the school district in maintaining accurate and comprehensive student transportation records. If it is necessary for a parent to accompany a child to school, it is suggested that the student ride the bus and the parent meet the student at the school building.

Regular student lunches will be available the first day. Elementary lunches are \$1.50, and milk is 45¢. Students may bring their entire lunch or may purchase their beverage. Snacks are available.

Kindergarten students will attend pre-arranged sessions on August 26 or August 27. On Thursday, August 28, morning students will take buses to school and be dismissed at 10:30 a.m.; afternoon kindergarten students will take buses to school and arrive at 2:15 p.m. and be dismissed with other students at the end of the day. On Friday, August 29, students will attend regularly scheduled kindergarten sessions.

Students can bring their own lunch to school or purchase a hot lunch from the cafeteria for \$1.50. Milk is 45¢.

School will be closed for Labor Day, Monday, September 1. Open House Nights will be held starting at 7 p.m. at the Wycallis Elementary School as follows: Thursday, August 28 for kindergarten, first grade, second grade and special subjects. Wednesday, September 10 for third grade, fourth grade and fifth grade. Parents should report to the gymnasium by 7 p.m.

Wycallis Elementary

Classes will begin at the Gerald J. Wycallis Elementary School on Tuesday, August 26.

Students in the first through fifth grades will attend full day

sessions from 9 a.m. to 3:40 p.m., beginning Tuesday, August 26. The school building will open at 9 a.m. to 3:40 p.m., beginning Tuesday, August 26. The school building will open at 9 a.m. Student supervision will begin at this time. On the first day, students in graders one through five will report directly to their classrooms. Faculty and staff will be available to assist students to their classrooms.

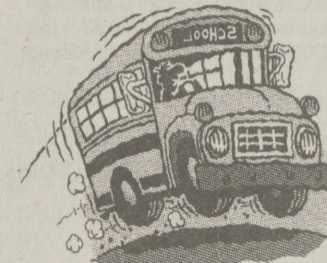

Dr. Gilbert Griffiths, Superintendent of the Dallas School District, announces the following bus schedules for the first day of school, Tuesday, August 26, 2003.

Due to the volume of calls received this time of year, parents are requested not to call the school district for bus times and locations. Please check the following information.

Gate of Heaven runs will be done first, followed by Dallas Secondary buses. Bishop Hoban High School and Wyoming Seminary Upper School students will be given the choice of riding a Gate of Heaven bus and transferring to the Hoban/Sem shuttle bus at Gate of Heaven or meeting the shuttle bus at the Gate of Heaven parking lot before 7:25 a.m. There will be no stop locations from Gate of Heaven to Seminary/Hoban.

Most routes will remain the same as last year. Unless a student is going home to a different location, the AM and PM bus numbers usually will be the same.

Some Elementary students may have to shuttle to their schools. Check the final destination from the following routes.

These bus lists will be in effect for the first week of school. Changes will be made where necessary in both times and locations as the school year progresses. Please note that all times are approximate.

The Kindergarten students are reminded of their participation in the school entry program. Their schedule will be given to them by their teachers at the screening conference prior to the opening of school. Mid-day bus numbers will be different.

The district announces that no unauthorized entry on a school bus will be allowed. Pennsylvania Title 18, Crimes and Offenses, states "...any per-

son who enters a school bus without prior authorization of the driver...commits a misdemeanor of the third degree."
