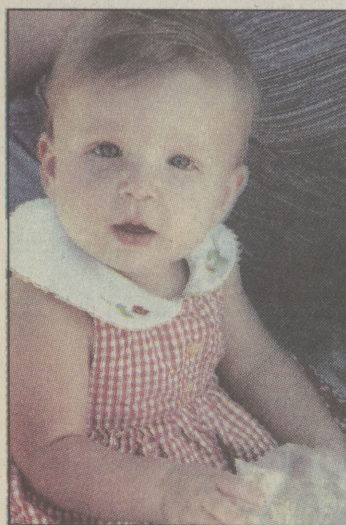
Fun day at the farm
