Recently, and for the third time, I read through Steve Covey's book, "First Things First." He uses four very familiar terms to capture principles of life in helping an individual develop his life mission. I want to use those same words but from a biblical-spiri-

To LIVE. Jesus said in John 14:6, "I am the way, the truth and the life; no one comes to the Father except through me."

Jesus told us that our access to God and eternal life is through Him. He is the only way. We are to trust in Him alone for our eternal destiny. Jesus provides life itself as our creator God (Colossians 1:16-17) and He also provides eternal life.

We can know that we have eternal life after this life because of what Jesus did on the cross for us (I John 5:11-12). Additionally, eternal life in Christ begins NOW, not in the distant future.
