

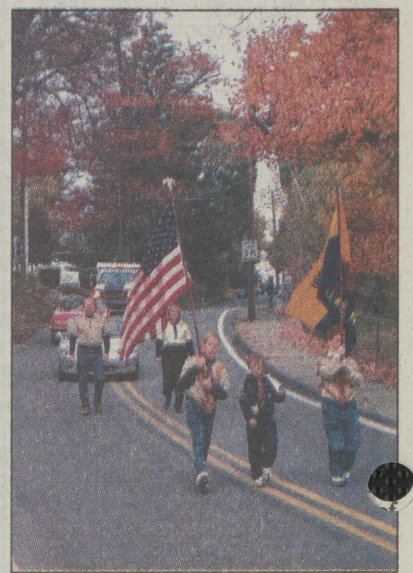
Goblins and princesses invade Dallas
