Dallas El team wins Stock Market Game

A team from Dallas Elementary School was recognized by Prudential Financial for its stock picking expertise in the 2002-2003 Stock Market Game competition conducted by The University of Scranton Center for Economic Education.

The Stock Market Game is a 10-week simulation during which students from three grade categories (4-6, 7-8, 9-12) invest an imaginary \$100,000 by buying stocks listed on the major securities exchanges. Students who compete in the game learn how financial markets operate and hone their mathematics and decision making skills. Separate competitions are held in the fall and spring. Team rankings are based on final portfolio values.

The University of Scranton is one of 11 colleges and universities in Pennsylvania that host Centers for Economic Education, each of which conducts its own Stock Market Game competition.

The Dallas Elementary team finished first in the 4th- to 6thgrade category in the spring competition, with a final portfolio value of over \$112,000.




