Warringtons will swing at Contra dance

The Chicory House and the Folklore Society will showcase local talent at a New England Contra Dance on Saturday January 3, at 8 p.m. The dance is held at the St. Therese's Church, Pioneer Avenue at Davis Street in Shavertown. No partner or previous experience is necessary, and all dances are taught and called.

The Warrington family band features a repertoire of American, Celtic and English Country dance tunes. They are joined by Lisa Burse and Rob Lewis. Lucy Warrington and Lisa play fiddle, while Jean Warrington and Rob Lewis will add rhythm acoustic guitar, and Peter Warrington will provide bass rhythm.

Caller Bob Nicholson of Syracuse has often teamed up with the group in other dance appearances.

Contra dancing probably began during the 1500s in English Villages, but the name contra derived from the French "contre" (opposite) to reflect the long line of dancers facing each other. Contra dance figures are either choral or couple. Choral

figures include moving the long lines simultaneously forward and back, or in groups of four in circles, stars, and heys (a figure eight pattern). Some of the couple figures include many common to square dancing, such as do-si-do, allemandes (turning by the right or left hand), and the balance and swing (a ballroom dance posi-

tion). Contra dancing is energetic and involves mixing with the other dancers as each couple performs a short routine with another couple before progressing onto the next couple and repeating the sequence. A different routine is taught before each dance by a caller who has everyone "walk through" the dance while explaining it. The dancing is moderately aerobic, but all figures can be accomplished with a walking step.
