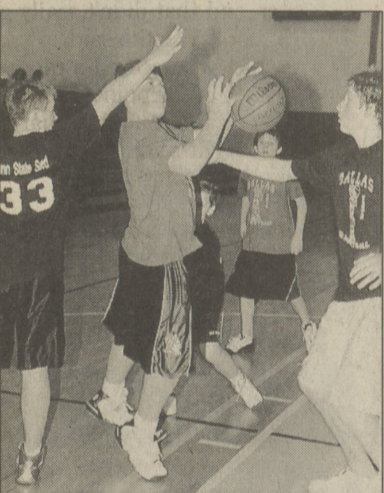

Mike Kravitsky led Dallas with 17 points, Kyle Arnaud had 9, and Myer Messinger 8.

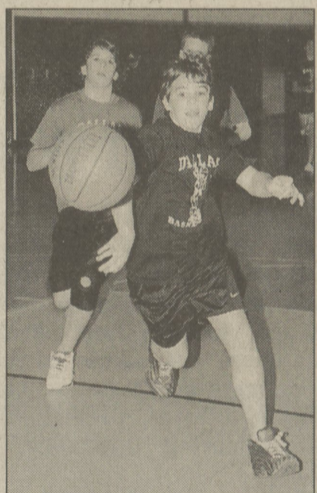
