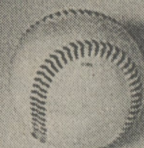
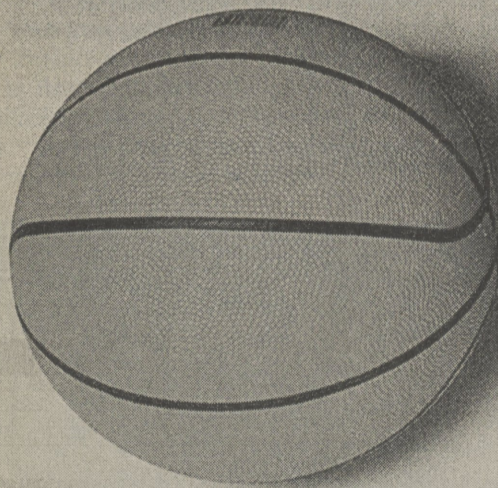
Eye Care Specialists 46, Franks Manufacturing 29
