Organ concert begins fine arts series

His concert will feature a variety of organ music from classics to patriotic to hymn arrangements, including his own arrangement of the William Tell Overture. The Charlotte Observer called his music "unbelievably inspiring." He is the designer of the organ at SUMC, and has played concerts all over the world for the past 30 years. A reception to meet the artist will follow the concert. Tickets are \$5 for adults and \$2 for children, and are available at the church by calling 675-3616 or at the door the night of the concert.
