which looked at the reality of the situation. "We have been talking about these two churches coming together for at least the last five years," she said. "There are so many Methodist churches in the Back Mountain which are reminiscent of the horse and buggy days when people couldn't drive miles to get to church. Now we find ourselves with smaller numbers and a duplication of services. We figured if we combined the two churches, we would be more efficient, have less work and more time to enjoy each other. "Change is not easy, but our

combined choirs are already proving to be tremendous." For the near future, the combined congregations of more than 400 people will worship and have Sunday school classes at the Lehman church off of Rt. 118. Russell is very protective of her parishioners' feelings and sensitive to the memories and the needs of both of her congregations. "Both of the buildings will be evaluated for their feasibility," she said, "and we will go from there. Right now we are using the Lehman church because it is a larger facility. We will later make a decision to reside in one and the other one will eventually be sold."

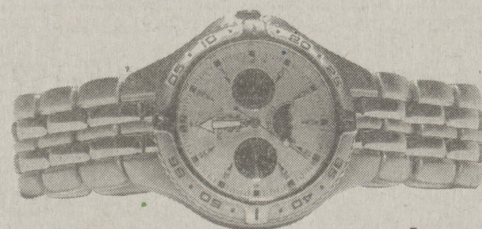
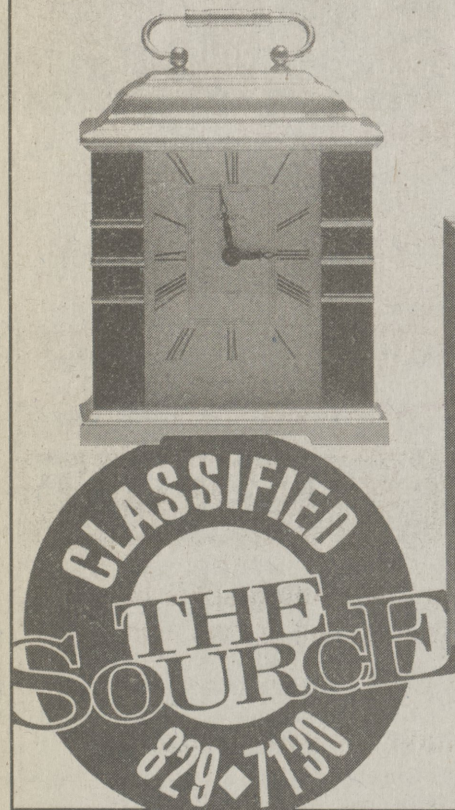
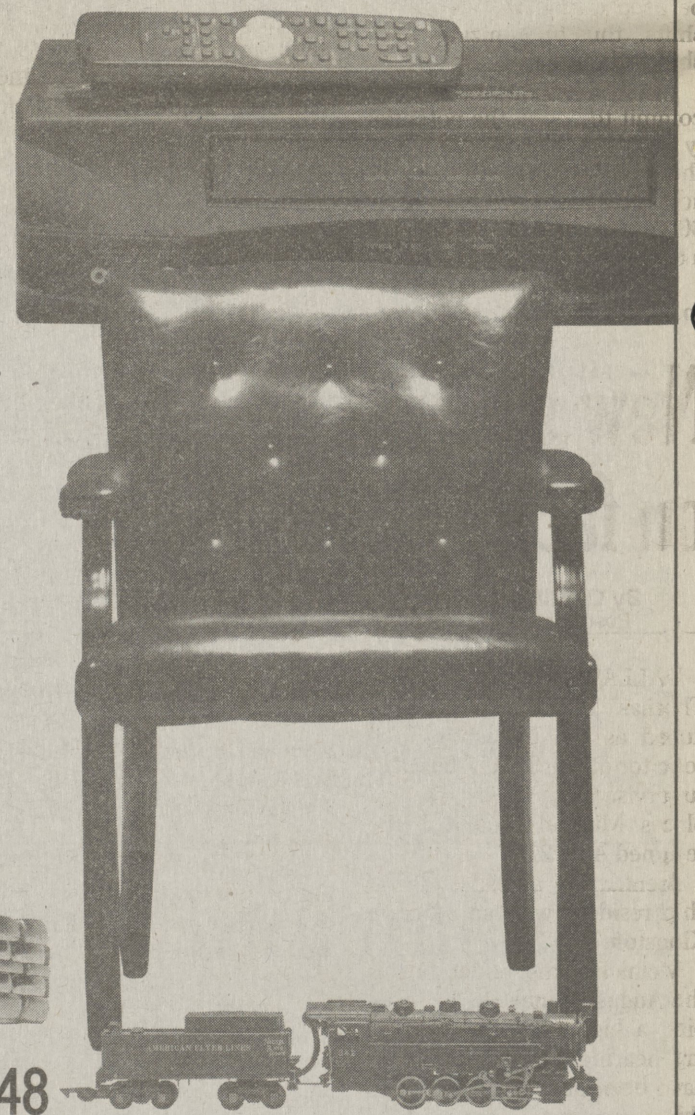
