Just click on "Merchandise," select "Misc. Items" and scroll down to the bird song audio identiflyer.

The device, which sells for \$35.50, comes with two audio cards, an earphone, a birdwatching guide booklet and three AAA batteries.

The cards that come with the Identiflyer are the Yard Bird Shop" for \$14.95 plus tax.

series. Each card has the name and a drawing of the bird. By pressing a button beside the each bird, the Identiflyer will play a short sample of the bird's song.


Other song card series cost \$10.50 plus tax and consist of one card each.
