the division, Samanas and Mike Race, who both average 14.7 yards per catch. Samanas has caught 27 passes for 398 yards and three touchdowns and

Dallas' lead scorers, Race Harris and Kelly had combined for 26 touchdowns through the Shoefield and Pimm had com bined for 12. Race also doubles as kicker for the Mountaineers, and he has put through 15 extra points and three field goals so far for a total of 78 points.
Dallas also leads Lehman in total offensive yards per game 351.9 to 266.3 and has allowe only 207 total yards on defens to Lehman's 336.8.
