startup of a new well have allowed the company's storage facilities to regain normal levels.

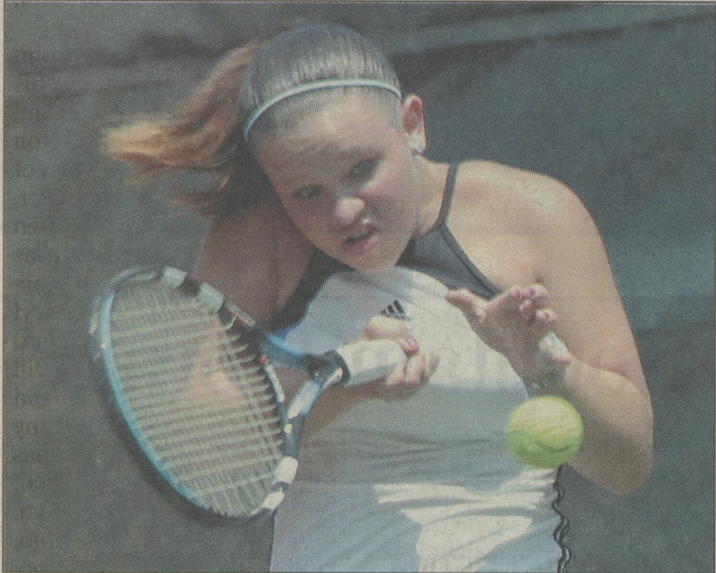

the sidewalk," she said last Wednesday. The project will take place in 200-foot increments in order not to disturb daily commerce.

Substantial funding for the project came through grants from PennDOT's T-21 endowment program. "That was the biggie," says LaBar.

The community has responded and is inspired by the project too. Twenty percent of the project's \$1.1 million have come from private donations, including money raised at an annual golf tournament, with help from the Tunkhannock Shade Tree Commission, notes LaBar. People's National Bank, with

a branch on Tioga Street, has coincidentally begun an exterior renovation that will include a new parking lot, landscaping, trees and similar "gaslight" black streetlights. Amy Walsh, branch manager, says the bank had talked for a while about the renovations and hopes they will be a complement to the

streetscape project.

LaBar notes that since the completion of a bypass around the downtown, the pressure, noise and dirt of hundreds of trucks passing through town each day to service the P & G plant in Mehoopany has eased and now is a good time for some fixing up.
