Members of the faculty from each building will conduct the presentation.

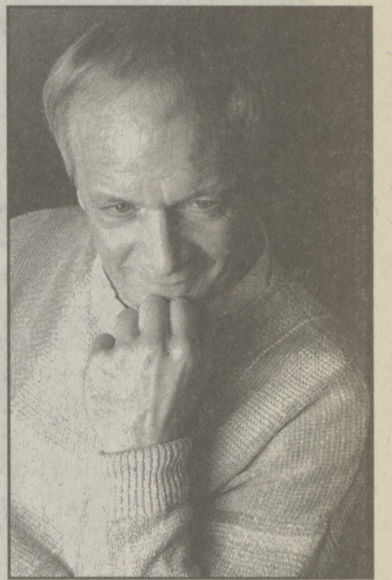

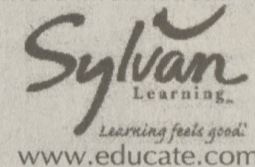
