Health Now, the borough has a goal to improve its image in the business community.

"It's important to identify that the borough is attractive to do business," said Moskovitz, who believes that having Health Now in the borough will someday open the door for more businesses to move the area. "It shows Dallas Borough

is an attractive place for business. That's the kind of expansion we want to facilitate."

Moskovitz hopes the business community in the Back Mountain continues to grow with the population. There are approximately 32,000 people who reside in the Back Mountain area and Moskovitz believes that number will grow significantly, especially in municipalities such as Dallas Township.

"The Back Mountain is going to grow," he said. "We need

to have smart growth."

Health Now signed a three-year lease at the Twin Stacks Center. The company is using approximately 25,000 square feet in the 100,000-square foot building.

"This is a great thing for the Back Mountain," said Moskovitz. "It's an incredibly exiting time, especially in Dallas Borough."
