Dallas baseball team completes fall season

The Dallas fall baseball team recently completed its regular season in the Wyoming Valley Fall Baseball League with a 7-13 record. The fall playoffs were suspended due to inclement weather. The regular season turned out to be a tune-up for veterans and a primary training period for nine players who had not appeared in varsity or junior varsity games last spring.

Leading the pitching staff were Dave Harding (3-2, 2.03 ERA) and Josh Shaver (2-2, 1.59 ERA). Tommy Parrish, Doug Harding and John Giampietro pitched a combined 50 innings, and each had solid outings. Myer Messinger pitched in some key spots late in the season.

Offensively, Greg Harris and Ryan Phillips set the pace with a .451 average and a .439 average, respectively. Harris also led the team in doubles (5), walks (17), and RBI (16). Parrish hit .408, with a home run and 10 RBI.

Konrad Kraszewski (.389), Joe Collini (.346), Ryan Konopki (.328), Dave Harding (.326.), and Giampietro (.303) provided key hits throughout the fall campaign.

Scott Skammer (.289) led the

team in runs scored (15) and stolen bases (5). Doug Harding, Dan Jacobs, Gerrid Kohli, Jordan Thimot, and Hunter Englehart made offensive contributions during the fall season.

Defensively, the Mountain-
