Jason Jolley receives Eagle Scout Award

Jason Robert Jolley of Dallas Boy Scout Troop 281 recently received his Eagle Scout Award during a ceremony at the Dallas United Methodist Church. Jolley earned the highest rank in scouting June 15, 2005, five days after graduating from Dallas High School.

The son of Robert and Mary Ellen Jolley of Dallas has been active in scouting since joining the Cub Scout Pack in Dallas as a Tiger Cub.

He moved through the Cub Scout ranks and was awarded the Arrow of Light Award, the highest award in Cub Scouting. Jolley advanced to Boy Scouts and continued his quest to become an Eagle Scout.

Jolley completed an Eagle Scout project at the Dallas Township recreational park on Sago Street in fall 2003. His project involved the restoration and construction of a walking trail around the perimeter of the park, building and placing several birdhouses throughout the park, and planting several trees along the newly-created trail.

Jolley sought the help of his uncle, Jack Reilly of Court Dale, to assist him in the creation of a sign for the park. Although he is attending college, Jolley remains active in Scouting.

the last day to file nominating petitions to get on the primary ballot. A candidate for state representative needs 300 signatures to get on the ballot.

Back Mountain municipalities which are part of the 117th District include the townships of Dallas, Franklin, Lake and Lehman, as well as the boroughs of Dallas, Harveys Lake, Noxen and Northmoreland.

"It has been an honor and a privilege to serve as the strong voice in Harrisburg for the people of the 117th Legislative District," said Hasay, who is the longest-serving current Republican member of the state House. "I very much appreciate the continued support that I have re-

ceived from the voters and I hope that I have lived up to the confidence and trust they have shown in me."

During his legislative career, the Shickshinny lawmaker helped craft compromise legislation that led to the enactment of Act 101 of 1988. Under the law, Pennsylvania became one of the first states in the nation to implement a comprehensive, statewide recycling program, which has been used as a model across the country.

He also authored language creating the very popular Pennsylvania Wild Resources Conservation Fund license plate in 1992 that has raised millions of dollars for wildlife projects. Hasay has received numerous awards for his legislative service.

The field for Lemmond's seat in Harrisburg is also crowded with Back Mountain residents.

Lisa Baker of Lehman Township, Russell Bigus of Dallas Township, David Madeira of Dallas, and Ronald Chvotzkin of Jackson Township have announced plans to run for the state Senate. All four are Republicans. There's also a possibility that Dallas resident Greg Skrepnek - a Luzerne County Commissioner - will seek the Democratic nomination.

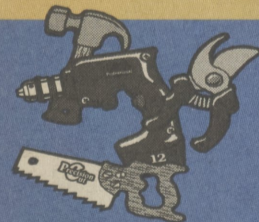

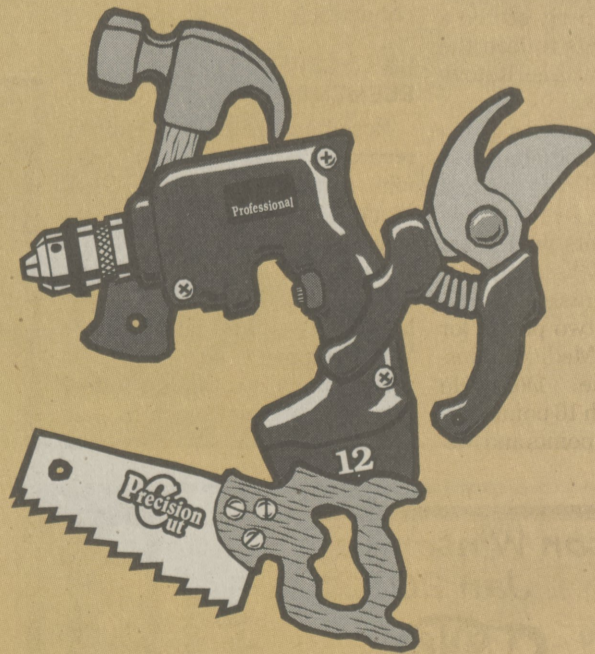
