Be sure to print your name, address and phone number on the back of the entry. Entries must be received no later than May 12.

Preliminary judging will be done by the Dallas School Disict. The designs of five finals will be given to the Dallas Harvest Festival committee for final judging.

In addition to having the artwork appear on letters and postcards, the winner will receive gift certificates from several Back Mountain businesses
