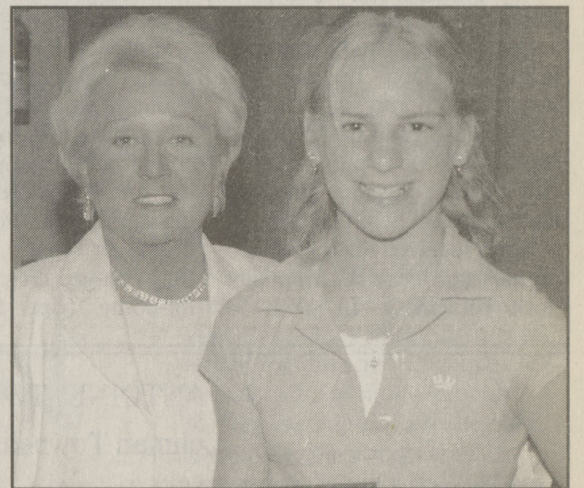
RESIDENTS AT THE MEADOWS ENJOY ACCORDION MUSIC
