

LAKE-LEHMAN

The Lake-Lehman School District has released the bus route schedule for the 2006-07 school year. Several routes have changed and other changes have been made because of flood damage earlier this summer.

LEHMAN-JACKSON ELEMENARY

(Note changes to bus routes 541 and 537)
No. 521, 7:50 a.m.: Jackson Road/Route 29 north: Start on Chase Road just past Mountain Road; picks up on Chase Road to Route 29 north, continues right onto Route 29 picking up all students on Route 29, Thorny Apple Acres, Route 29, picks up Summit, Cedar, Pearl, back to Route 29 picking up Lakeside Dr., turn around behind Lake-Silkworth, turns right on Route 29N picking up only students living on the north-bound side of the highway. Continues down Route 18B and picks up on Mill Street/Mountain View before heading to school. 2:45 p.m.: Same

No. 534, 7:10 a.m.: Idetown/Old Lake Road: Start Idetown Road to Route 415 to Lakeside Drive to post office to Old Lake Road to Route 415 to Briarcrest to 42nd Street to Route 415; cross over to 42nd Street to Idetown Road to Oak, to Idetown Road to Route 18B to Lehman-Jackson Elementary. 2:45 p.m.: Reversed

No. 733, 7:20 a.m.: Hoover/Lehman/Outlet to Outlet/Meeker to Sholtis to Zosh/De to Meeker to Meeker/Outlet to Lehman/Outlet to Trovelli Switch to turnaround; back to Lehman/Outlet Road to Route 18B west to Market Street to Lehman-Jackson Elementary. 2:45 p.m.: Reversed

No. 346, 7:10 a.m.: Jackson Road to Smith Pond Road to Jackson-Church Road to Jackson Road to Town and Country Manor to Auburn to LaSalle to Greenwich to Jackson Road to Old Route 15 to Church Road to Huntsville Road to Follies Road to Jackson Road to Mountain View to Sutton Lane, turnaround back to Mountain View to Lehman-Jackson Elementary. 2:45 p.m.: Reversed

No. 537, 7 a.m.: Hillside/Chase: Starts at Rolling Meadows to Fieldcrest to Church Road, turn around at church, back to Hillside Road to Chase Road to Highland and West Meadow to Briarwood and West Meadow to Chase Road to Gates Road to Hardisky to Gates and Kasco to turnaround; Twin Oaks (Rosenbaum's) back to Chase Road to Maple picking up at the corner of Maple and Meadowcrest, and Maple and Oak Drive, takes right to Heritage Hills stopping at the top corner and again moving to cul-de-sac, turns around back to Oak Drive stopping at Oak Drive and Cherry, takes left onto Cherry stopping at Cherry and Meadowcrest, proceeds to Chase Road turning right and then left onto Huntsville

Road to Old Route 15 to pick up students on Market Street to Lehman-Jackson Elementary. 2:45 p.m.: Starts on Market Street then same as above

No. 549, 7:25 a.m.: Trojan Road, Route 29 south, Route 18B west to Trojan Road to Crossen Road to Route 29 south to Swamp Road to Lake Avenue, Pearl Street, Rand J Guns, Carol Street to Sayre/Roaring Brook Road (Country Crest Trailer Court) to Route 29S to Sawmill Road to Hartman Road to Route 29S to Fedor Road to Route 18E to Lehman-Jackson Elementary. 2:45 p.m.: Same

No. 541, 7:05 a.m.: Huntsville/Chase/Plymouth Mountain: Starts at Steele Road in church parking lot, left on Weavertown to Jesse Road; turns around, left on Mountain Road, picking up at corner of Cigarski and Mountain roads; right on Chase Road to left on Pine Tree, turn around at Salanski, left on Chase picking up Huntsville Road. Turns left and picking up on Huntsville Road takes left onto Hillside then right on Hillside and picking up Huntsville/Idetown Road to right on Route 18B to Lehman-Jackson Elementary. This bus no longer goes to Meadowcrest. 2:45 p.m.: Huntsville/Idetown Road to Huntsville Road to Chase then reverse.

No. 539: Sutton Hills: Old Route 15 to Sutton Road to Woodridge, turn around to Sutton Road to Blueberry Hill Road to Cross Creek and Blueberry Hill to Cross Creek Road - turnaround to Deer Hill to Beaver Brook to Bullford Road to Fairfield to Oldfield and Longmeadow to Stonybrook, Turn around at Hampton Road to Bullford to Overbrook Road to Old Route 15 to Hayfield Road to Old Route 15 to Lehman-Jackson Elementary School. 2:45 p.m.: Same

No. 349, 7:15 a.m.: Meeker/Route 18B/Huntsville: Route 18B to right on Loyalville Road to left on Pine Tree to left on Route 29 to left on Route 18B to left at Pikes Creek Park to right on Cornell Road to Meeker/Outlet Road to Meeker Road to Route 18E to Shelley's Trucking to Golf Course Road to Idetown/Huntsville Road to Route 18W, crossover Route 18B to Idetown road to Vine, Park, Hilltop Drive, Hemlock, Pine, Maple to right on Route 18W to Firehouse Road to Outlet Road to Route 18B - cross to Hill Street to Market Street to Lehman-Jackson Elementary School. 2:45 p.m.: Reversed

ROSS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

No. 421, 7:05 a.m.: Broadway Road to left on Nevell Hollow Road to right on Hunlock - Harveysville Road to right on Silo Road to left on Bloomingdale Road to right on Twinbrook Road to left on Shiny Road to left on Hunlock - Harveysville Road to left on Bloomingdale Road continue across Silo Road to Bloomingdale Road to left on Broadway Road to right on Cannonball Road to left on Bear Swamp Road to left on Henrico Road to right on Broadway Road to D and E Fuel turn around continue on Broadway Road to Broadway corners to right on

Grange Hall Road turn around at Post's, back to Broadway Corners to right on Broadway Road to left on Gray Road to right on Peat Moss Road to left on Broadway Road to right on Schoolhouse Road to left on Main Road to left into Ross Elementary. 2:45 p.m.: Schoolhouse Road to left on Broadway Road to right on Peat Moss Road to left on Gray Road to left on Broadway Road to right on Nevell Hollow then continue same as morning route.

No. 422, 7:10 a.m.: Route 18B at Sheldon's Lunch to right on Whitesell Road to right on Bronson Road to right on Mooretown road to right on Route 29 to right on Gordon Road to right on Macri Road cross Route 18B to Lamoreaux Road to left on Main Road to left on Sait-Moyer Road to left on Route 29 to left on Marchikitus Road to left on Main Road to left on Pall Road to turnaround, back on Pall Road to left on Niemczyk Road to right on Callender Road to left on Main Road to County Road turnaround, back up County Road to right on Main Road to left into Ross Elementary. 2:45 p.m.: Reversed

No. 423, 7:15 a.m.: Start at Evergreen Park on Mooretown Road to left on Mooretown Road to right on Mahoney Road to right on Old State Road to right on Route 18B to Maransky Road turnaround, Route 18B East to right on Harris Pond Road to right on Main Road to right on North Lake Road to top of hill turn around, back to right on Main Road to right on Old Post Office Road to left on Grassy Pond Road to right on Broadway Road to left on Skurat Road to left on Sweet Valley Road to left on Sylvan Lake Road turnaround at PA Fish Commission to left on Sweet Valley Road to left into Ross Elementary. 2:45 p.m.: Reversed

No. 424, 7:15 a.m.: Start at Route 18B and Whitesell Road, continue on Route 18B West to right on Old State Road to right on Mahoney Road to left on Mooretown Road to left on Route 18B to right on Grassy Pond Road to right on Gray Road to left on Peat Moss Road to right on Broadway Road to left on Left on Skurat Road to left on Sweet Valley Road to left on Sylvan Lake Road turnaround at PA Fish Commission to left on Sweet Valley Road to left into Ross Elementary. 2:45 p.m.: Reversed

LAKE-NOXEN ELEMENTARY

(Note changes to routes 312, 315, 317, 511, 714, Route 713 has been removed.)

No. 511, 7:15 a.m.: Start at the United Methodist Church on Route 29, Picks up on Maple St., Route 29 to Island Road, Island Road, Elizabeth, Tannery, Schneck Street, Stull Road from Schneck to Main, bottom of Dimmock Hill; Route 29 both ends to Route 415. Left pick up at Pine Street, Harveys Lake. 2:45 p.m.: Reversed

No. 312, 7:25 a.m.: Harveys Lake Route 415 Marina Townhouses picks up on Ridge Ave., Hillside, Carpenter Road takes right on Ridge, right on Hillside, right on Route 415 to Warden

Place picks up on 1st Street, High Street, right onto 2nd Street. Turnaround Hemlock Gardens, 2nd Street to Route 415, Proceeds to Lake-Noxen Elementary. 2:45 p.m.: Reversed

No. 714, 7:05 a.m.: Loyalville, Outlet and Point Breeze, Starts out on Mooretown Road picking up from Crisman/Bronson Road to Route 29 takes right on Route 29S picking up to Route 18B, turns around back to ROUTE 29N takes right to Pine Tree Road, picks up along Pine Tree Road, takes left onto Loyalville Road, picks up on Loyalville to Outlet Road, takes right on Outlet Road, picks ups along Outlet Road to Dog House (does not pickup Keefer Plot) takes left onto Route 415/Lakeside Drive to Road Ave. to Lake-Noxen Elementary. This run will now pick up any student of the Lake-Noxen School residing from Outlet Road around Harveys Lake (Route 415) and including Road Ave. 2:45 p.m.: Reversed

No. 315, 7:40 a.m.: Noxen/back side of Harveys Lake: Starts in Stull, picks up on Dutch Row, the Store at corner of Main and Route 29. Continues down Route 29S picking up after last Road to Dimmock Hill, (does not pick up Dimmock Hill) picks up from there and including Route 415, Blue Jay Trailer Park, takes a right and picks up on Pine Street, takes right on Halowick Road, left on Tulp, at stop sign - right on Chestnut Tree Road, turnaround, back on Chestnut Tree to intersection, turns right onto Schoolhouse Road, turnaround at Dragons, takes right onto Church Road, turns around at Church, takes right on West Point Ave. to Lake-Noxen Elementary. 2:45 p.m.: Reversed

No. 316, 7 a.m.: Sorber Mountain/Mooretown/back side of Harveys Lake: Starts Mooretown Road to Route 29N, Noxen Road, turnaround to Route 29S, Sorber Mountain Road, to Route 29S, North Mountain Road, Crisman Road, Mooretown Road, Route 29N to Maple Tree Road, left on Tulp, at stop sign - right on Chestnut Tree Road, Queen Of Peace Road to Lake-Noxen Elementary School. 2:45 p.m.: Reversed

No. 317, 7:40 a.m.: Harveys Lake, start on Lehman/Outlet Road First stop just before Meeker Road, then picks up at Keefer Plot. (Note new pickup area) travels around Route 415 Harveys Lake picking up all students from the Outlet towards Sunset, Warden Place, Alderson, to the Lake-Noxen School. This bus will only pick up students on the Lake Road; it will not travel up side streets. 2:45 p.m.: Reversed

No. 544, 6:35 a.m.: Chase Road to right on Route 29 to Thorny Apple Acres - turnaround - back to Route 29N to right on Summit, left on Cedar to left on Pearl to right on Route 29N to Lakeside Drive to Cease Terrace - turnaround - back to Route 29N to 18E to Lake-Lehman

No. 740, 6:25 a.m.: Old Route 15 to Sutton Road to Woodridge, turn around to Sutton Road to Blueberry Hill Road to Cross Creek and Blueberry Hill to Cross Creek Road, turn around, to Deer Hill to Beaver Brook to Bullford Road to Fairfield to Oldfield and Longmeadow to Stony Brook, turn around at Hampton Road to Bullford to Overbrook Road to Old Route 15 to Hayfield to Old Route 15 to the Jr./Sr. High School. 2:40 p.m.: Same

No. 750, 6:30 a.m.: Loyalville and Loyalville Outlet to Route 29N to Chestnut Tree Road to Bear Hollow Road to Loyalville Outlet to left on Loyalville Road to Pine Tree Road to right on Hickory Tree Road to Maple Tree Road to Route 29 to Gordon Road to turnaround at Gordon's back to Route 29S to Route 18E to left on Cornell Road to Loyalville Road - cross over to Meeker/Outlet Road to Meeker Road to Route 18E to Golf Course Road to Idetown/Huntsville Road to Route 18W to Firehouse Road to Outlet Road to Route 18W to Mountain View Drive to Lake-Lehman Junior/Senior High School. 2:40 p.m.: Reversed
