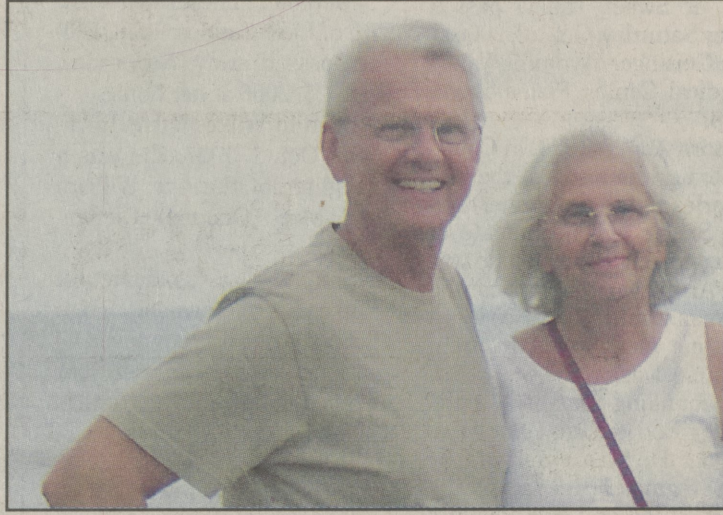


PRAYER SHAWLS MADE BY DALLAS UMC WOMEN

"Everyone there does it out of compassion," said Weinman, who added the facility does not receive any funding from the Ecuadorian government. "The parents are so appreciative. Every parent volunteers a couple of hours each week at the school. Camp Hope is an amazing organization."

Weinman says very few children in Ecuador receive regular medical care.

"They see a doctor, but not very often," she said. "They do have a hospital (in Quito), but that's mostly for emergencies. The children don't receive constant checkups."

The Weinmans also volunteer their time locally. And they know they're not the only local residents who have visited Ecuador - or other Third World countries - to provide care to needy children. Shavertown plastic surgeon Dr. Francis Colini and his wife Susan have been traveling to Ecuador for years to help treat children born with severe birth defects.

"I know the work of Dr. Colini very well," said Weinman. "It shows there are a lot of wonderful people in this country. There are a lot of people who enjoy helping others."

The Weinmans are planning to return to Ecuador in July - if not sooner.

"We'd love to go back in the spring, but I don't know if that's possible," said Suzy Weinman, who has been sending care packages to the children. "The next time we go, we don't have to go with the group. The facility knows us. We're looking forward to going back. Everyone is so grateful for the help. We fell in love with the children."
