Men from all Back Mountain churches are encouraged to attend. For more information, call Bob Deeble at 696-2148.

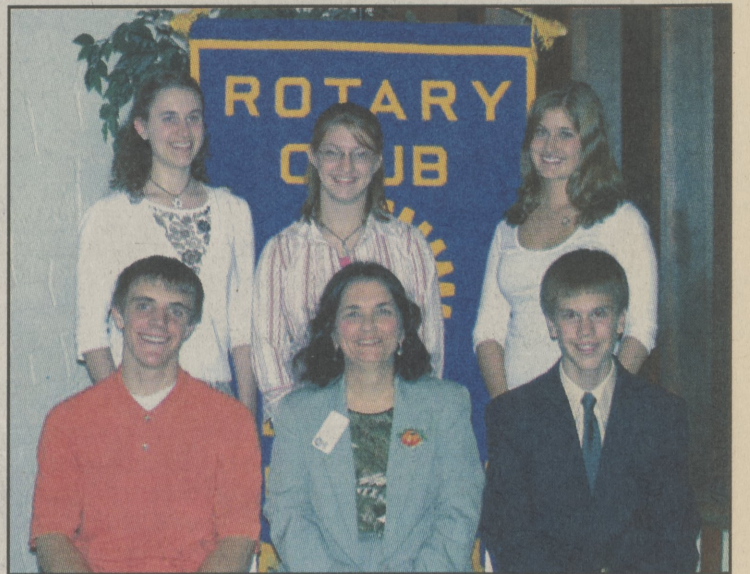
Awana Club meets at Grace Community

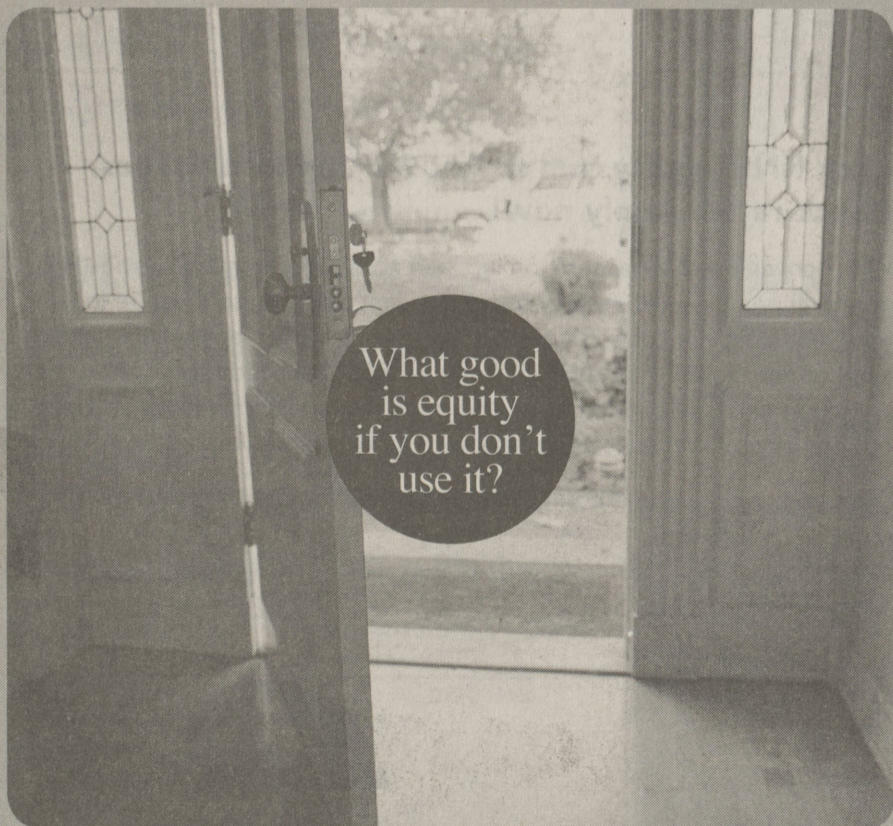

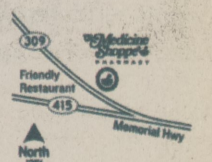
