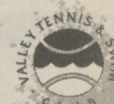
The Sunday meetings will be held at 6 p.m.

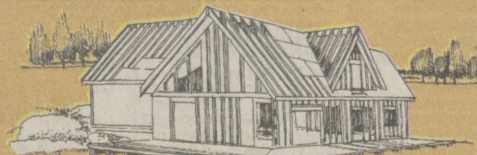
