## This shop inspires local artists

Inspire Art Gallery, owned by Lisa Boucher, recently opened its doors on Route 415 in Dallas and features items hand crafted by local artists.

Boucher, who claims she is no artist herself, owned a small craft store for seven years and wanted to bring her love of art here.

And so Inspire Art Gallery was born.

In all, 22 local artists supply the store with their work. At Inspire, shoppers will find art work in a wide range of media.

Boucher gets a 25 percent com-

mission on items that sell and the artists keep the rest. She suggests selling prices to them, but said most of the time the artists have a pretty good idea what their pieces are worth.

Boucher was worried she wouldn't get enough artists' work, but now has little room left to display the many items her small store across from the Twin Stacks Center has accumulated. She hopes to showcase a new artist's work every 30 days and post biographies of them next to their work.

### Dallas Borough enforces maintenance

The Dallas Borough Codes Enforcement Office announces the seasonal enforcement of the Dallas Borough Property Maintenance Code. Property owners should be alerted that inspections will be scheduled for all property owners deemed in violation of the code and the borough will prosecute all offenders through the enforcement of the regulations.

Recent routine property inspections in neighborhoods throughout the borough revealed numerous violations, including exterior property violations for property owners failing to maintain their premises in a clean, safe and sanitary condition. The borough will require property owners to remove all vehicles not properly registered and inspected, inoperable motor vehicles, failure to cut grass, appliances littering yards, debris, and rubbish or other inappropriate materials littering yard areas.

Dallas Borough officials strongly urge all property owners to respect their neighborhoods recognizing the quality of life that borough residents have long enjoyed.

### Dallas Borough yard regulations

The residents and property owners of Dallas Borough are reminded that the borough's "Weed Nuisance Ordinance" requires that all grass and weeds within the borough limits be cut and removed no later than July 1 of each year or earlier if necessary.

Under the borough ordinance, property owners who fail to comply with the Weed Ordinance are in violation and subject to a fine. All property owners are asked to please comply with the Borough Weed Ordinance.

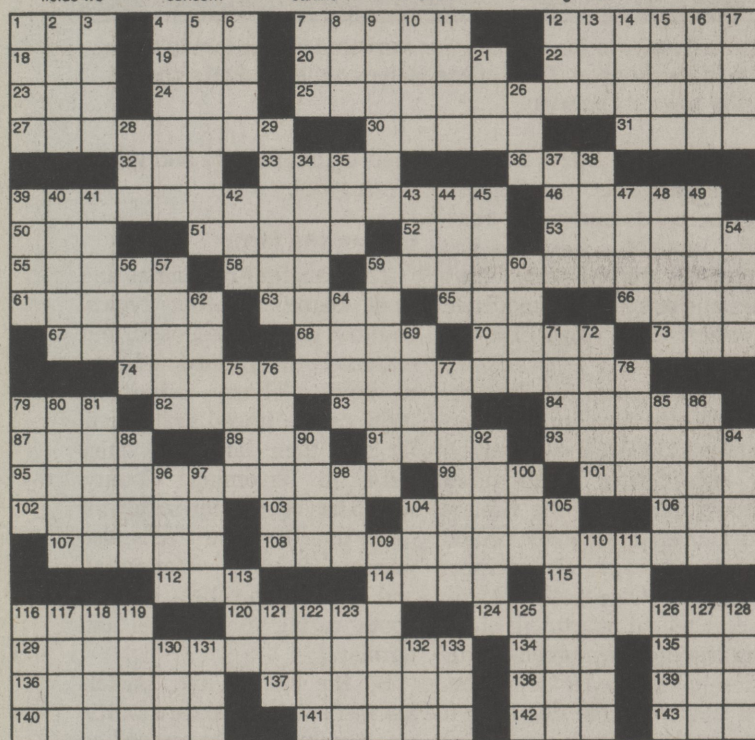
The Auxiliary of The Meadows Nursing Center in Dallas is holding its annual membership drive. Memberships are open to all residents of the community. Memberships cost \$8.
