Westfield achieved the rank of Hospital Corpsman Chief Petty Office and was the Directorate Leading Chief of Nursing Services at the Camp Lejeune Naval Hospital, Camp Lejeune.

He was a member of the Chief Petty Officers Association and coordinator of The Naval Hospital, Camp Lejeune Honors Detail. Chief Petty Officer Westfield was a highly-decorated 20-year Naval veteran who served in Iraq and many Naval and Marine installations.
