

Building honors Chief Westfield

A new educational facility built next to The Camp Lejeune Naval Hospital on the Naval-Fleet Compound Grounds at Camp Lejeune, NC, was dedicated to Chief John M. Westfield Hospital Corpsman in honor and memory of his life and service by the Navy and Marines.

Chief Petty Officer Hospital Corpsman John-Mark Westfield, 38, stationed at Camp Lejeune, NC., was killed in an auto accident on February 19, 2007.

He was the son of The Rev. Henry E. Sr. and Alice Westfield, of Dallas. A 1986 graduate of Dallas Area High School, he attended Recruit Training in Orlando, Florida and Hospital Corpsman School in Great Lakes, Ill. He earned his Associate Computer Science Degree from The New England Institute of Technology and was near completion of his full Degree in Computer Science.

Westfield achieved the rank of Hospital Corpsman Chief Petty Officer and was the Directorate Leading Chief of Nursing Services at the Camp Lejeune Naval Hospital, Camp Lejeune.

He was a member of the Chief Petty Officers Association and coordinator of The Naval Hospital, Camp Lejeune Honors Detail. Chief Petty Officer Westfield was a highly-decorated 20-year Naval veteran who served in Iraq and many Naval and Marine installations.

A plaque with a picture of Chief Westfield and a painting of a Marine and a Medivac helicopter were presented to Mrs. John-Mark Westfield and the couple's daughter, Bianca, by Captain Mark C. Olesen, Commanding

Officer, Camp Lejeune; and Master Chief Kevin Kesterson.

The plaque with the dedication message will hang directly inside the entrance to the building.

Chief Petty Officer Hospital Corpsman Timothy Wones read the dedication and memorial statement, honoring Chief John M. Westfield.

The new \$325,000 Operational Medicine Training Facility is outfitted with state-of-the-art equipment that will assist the nurses

and doctors training the Medical Corpsmen and Corpwomen.

These docs, as called by the Marines, will provide critical care to the critically wounded on the battlefield and then, in conjunction with doctors and nurses, at mobile fleet hospitals, small hospitals that can be set up near the front lines.

The facility will also be used for community preparation for disaster and for pre-deployment practical skills for years to come.
