**Master Gardener Training to be held**

Penn State Cooperative Extension in Luzerne County is now accepting applications for the Penn State Master Gardener training program to be conducted this fall. Penn State Master Gardeners are members of the community who have an interest in gardening and a desire to help others.

The Penn State Master Gardener training program will be conducted on Tuesdays from September 4-December 4 (exception of Monday, October 29) from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. The training classes will be held at the Luzerne County Extension office, 16 Luzerne Ave., Suite 200, West Pittston. There will be a program fee of \$75 per person or \$110 per couple to cover the cost of the training manual, Penn State publications, and other support materials. In exchange for the horticulture instruction, candidates must agree to donate 50 hours of volunteer service to Penn State Cooperative Extension within the first year. The application deadline is August 17.
