ing. The Grotto has provided employment to many residents of Harveys Lake over the past 54 years. Paglianite has also been active in the Rotary Club for many years and has devoted many hours of his time in helping the less fortunate.

Pomrinke was diagnosed with Stage Four breast cancer three months after giving birth to her first child, Kira. She walked in the Breast Cancer 3-Day Walk last year, just one-and-a-half months before her death. Pomrinke was determined to find a cure so her daughter would never have to endure the disease.
