#### **MU** professor co-authors paper

Grace Fisher, Ed.D., O.T.R./L., associate professor and interim chair of occupational therapy at Misericordia University, had a grounded theory paper

Care Journal. The report, "A Model of **Occupational Empowerment** for Marginalized Populations in Community Environments," describes a theoretical model they developed after working at a homeless shelter for women and children. The model proposes the

potential power of occupation or purposeful activity in helping individuals overcome learned helplessness syndrome.

Dr. Fisher and Hotchkiss contend that, through involvement in valued activities with the guidance of an occupational therapist, people may reverse the learned helplessness cycle and live more productive lives.

They will also present the paper in October at the 30th Annual Pennsylvania Occupational Therapy Association Conference in Harrisburg.

Dr. Fisher has a Bachelor of Arts degree in psychology from Wilkes University and a postbaccalaureate certificate of proficiency in occupational therapy. She also has a master's degree in human services administration from Misericordia University and a doctorate in educational administration from Temple University.


