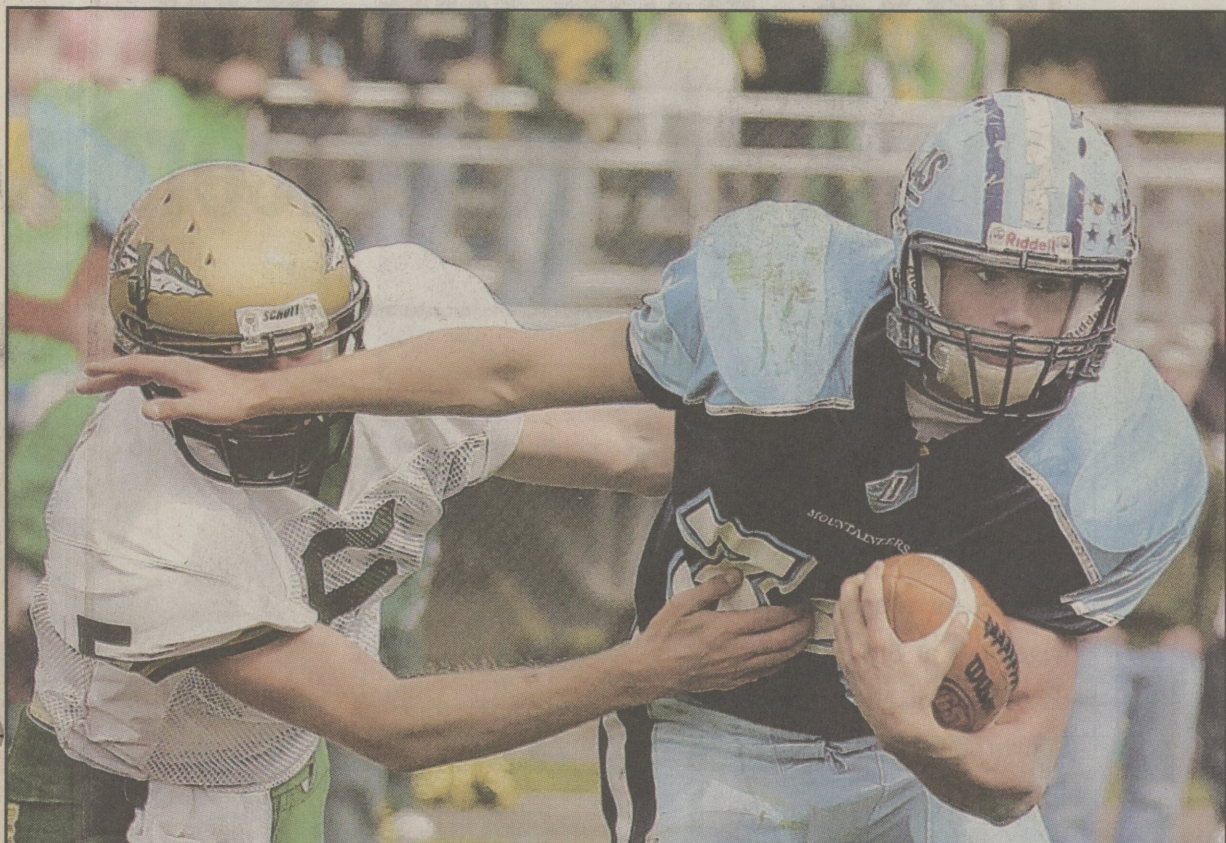


DALLAS HOMECOMING

The week of festivities kicked off with the first outdoor pep rally at Mountaineer Stadium in years. Students celebrated Homecoming with the following dress-up themes each day:

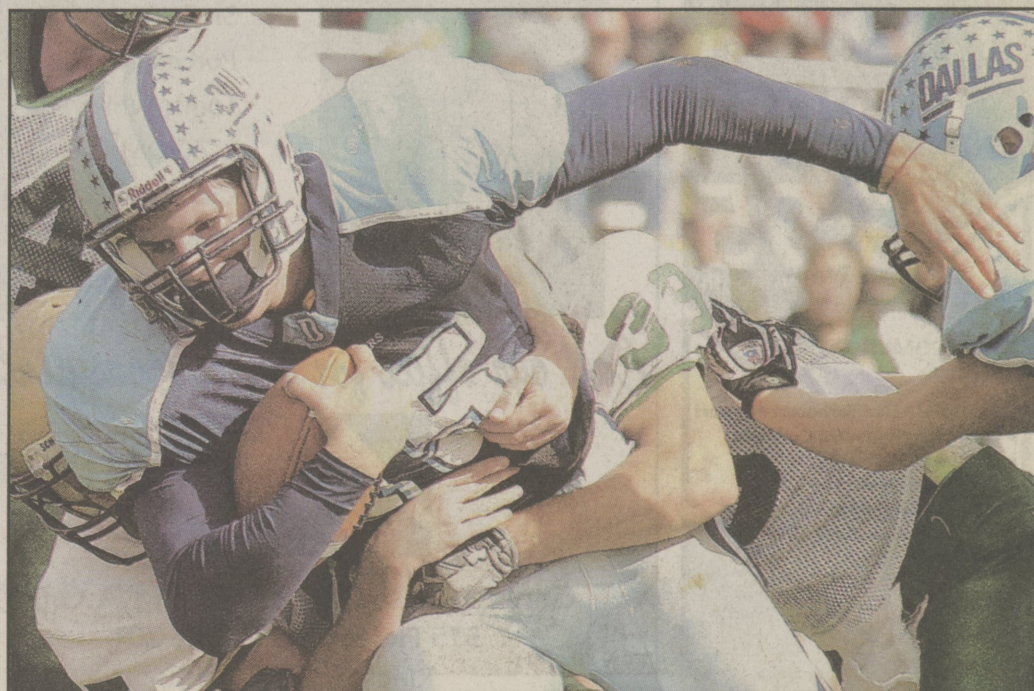
