## You can learn to survive outdoors

Misericordia University will host a two-day Wilderness First Aid (WFA) training course on campus for students, employees and the community from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday, March 29 and 30. The 16-hour course will be divided into two eight-hour sessions.

The course is perfect for the outdoor enthusiast, outdoor leader, camp staff or anyone interested in specialty medicine. It will focus on

skills such as response and assessment for musculoskeletal injuries, environmental emergencies, soft tissue injuries, medical emergencies and survival skills.

SOAR, Misericordia's Student Outdoor Adventure and Recreation program, is sponsoring the event. It will be instructed by the Stone Hearth Open Learning Opportunities, better known as SOLO, which has been instructing outdoor skills courses since 1975.

Participants will receive SOLO WFA certification that is good for two years and is accepted by the American Camp Association.
