Blithe Spirit' comes to Dallas

As a young child, Chris Jayne was asked to play a character in an annual Thanksgiving play at Dallas Elementary School. The experience hooked him and now the 18-year-old Dallas High School senior has the lead male role in the school's upcoming spring production.


During elementary school, Jayne had the opportunity to act in chorus and band presentations, playing key roles of Tom Sawyer and a clown. Middle school brought a lapse in his acting because he was a saxophonist in the jazz band, which consumed much of his time. But as a freshman in high

school, Jayne landed a minor role as a character's boyfriend who just said, "OK" in the play "John nnon and Me."

From there, I kind of said, 'This is great and I'm going to keep doing this," he said.

He landed the role of Captain Lombard in "And Then There Were None" and later played Hansel in the children's musical, "The Marvelous Adventures of Red Riding Hood," Clouseau in "The Pink Panther Strikes Again" and Richard III in "The Final Trial of Richard III."

In his current role as Charles Condomine, Jayne is an eccentric English author writing a book on supernatural phenomenon who invites a female fortune teller and psychic to help him understand what she does. He doesn't believe her until she brings back the ghost of his deceased wife, which moves in with Condomine and his current wife, creating con-


