p.m. Earlier in the day, he will share his 30 years of television directing experience during an open faculty luncheon beginning at noon in Mercy Hall, room 325.

The "SNL" director has completed productions for eight networks, ranging from documentaries to musicals.

He has directed more live network television than any director in the history of the medium and his network assignments have taken him to 20 countries and 38 states.

In recent years, King has directed Ted Koppel's first live town meeting for the Discovery Channel and three syndicated series: "Life & Style," for Sony Pictures; "Living It Up with Ali and Jack," for King World; and "Naomi's New Morning," for the Hallmark Channel.

He also directed the live finales for the first four "Survivor" series for CBS.

King has won three Emmys for his work - one for directing "The Mike Douglas Show," another for producing and directing "Toys on the Town," a musical special with Shields and Yarnell; and the third for heading the design team that revamped the graphic look of CBS News.

He has also been nominated 17 Emmys as a writer, producer and director.


