Gary Sabulski, age 6, won a prize for the largest golden trout (1 pound); Nathan Maransky, age 8, won a prize for the largest

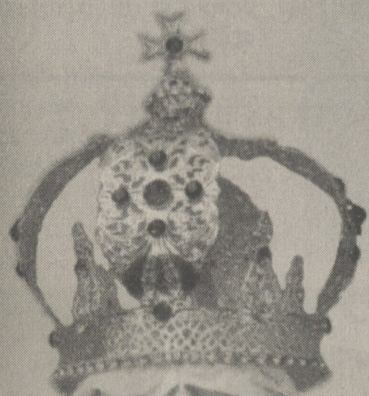
brook trout (1.2 pounds); and Darren Kerdesky, age 7, won a prize for the largest rainbow trout (4.2 pounds).

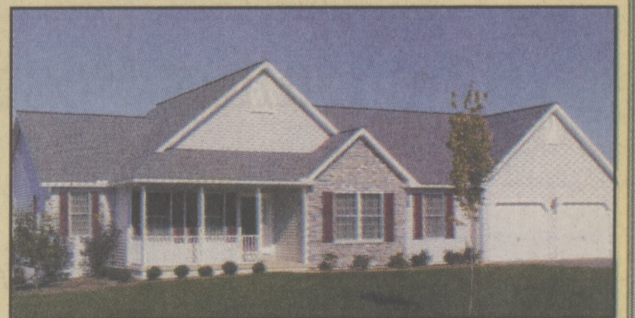

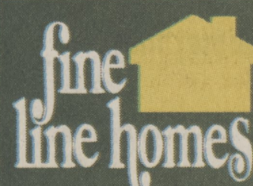
