the University of Virginia in Charlottesville, Va. and will spend two weeks at Fort Lee, Va. for officer leadership training.

At the earliest, Dunn would leave for Iraq in July. He has not yet received notice of his training dates but, after he completes training, he will attend drill one weekend every month.

Some of the basic JAG requirements include being a graduate of an American bar approved law school, a member in good standing of the bar association in the JAG's state, good character and physical fitness.

The selection process is extremely competitive and requires letters of recommendation. According to Dunn, there are only about 20 JAGs in the Pennsylvania Army National Guard.

While working as an assistant district attorney, Dunn will handle military legal matters throughout the year. He can become activated or even deployed to war. He will accept any task assigned to him but es-
