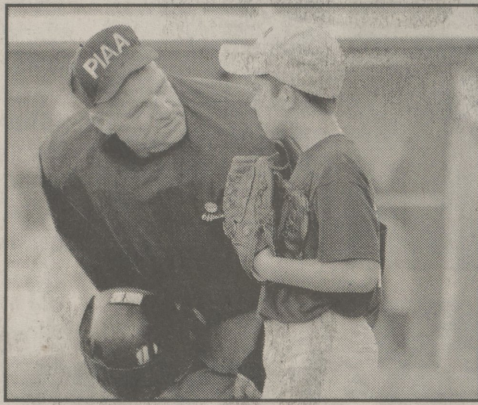




Members of the Dodgers team celebrate their 2-1 win over the Giants in the National League playoff game at the Back Mountain Little League.

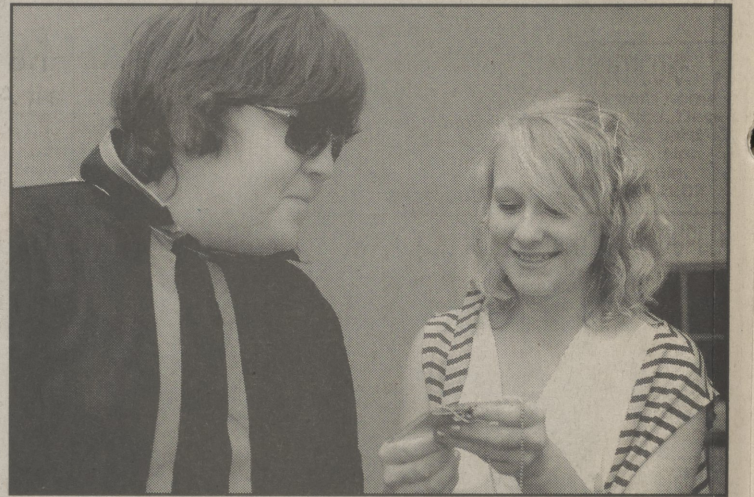
Dallas United Methodist Church
