Find out what's in drinking water

A comprehensive package of drinking water tests will be available to Harveys Lake residents by Wilkes University together with the Harveys Lake Environmental Advisory Council on July 12. A free follow-up Question & Answer session on water well systems will be offered on August 2.

The cost of the testing package this year is \$75. The Wilkes University Water Quality Laboratory will measure residents' water for pH, conductivity, turbidity, total coli form, nitrate-nitrite, phosphate, fecal coli form, fecal streptococcus, corrosively, hardness, iron, manganese and copper.

Interested residents can pick up water sampling kits at the Harveys Lake Borough Building's meeting room (8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday) until July 12 and drop off their water samples at the same place between 10 a.m. and noon on Saturday, July 12. Final results will be confidentially mailed to participants directly from the Wilkes laboratory within two weeks of the testing date.

The testing follow-up and well water Q&A session will be conducted at 10 a.m. Saturday, Aug. 2, by Brian Oram, a professional biologist.




