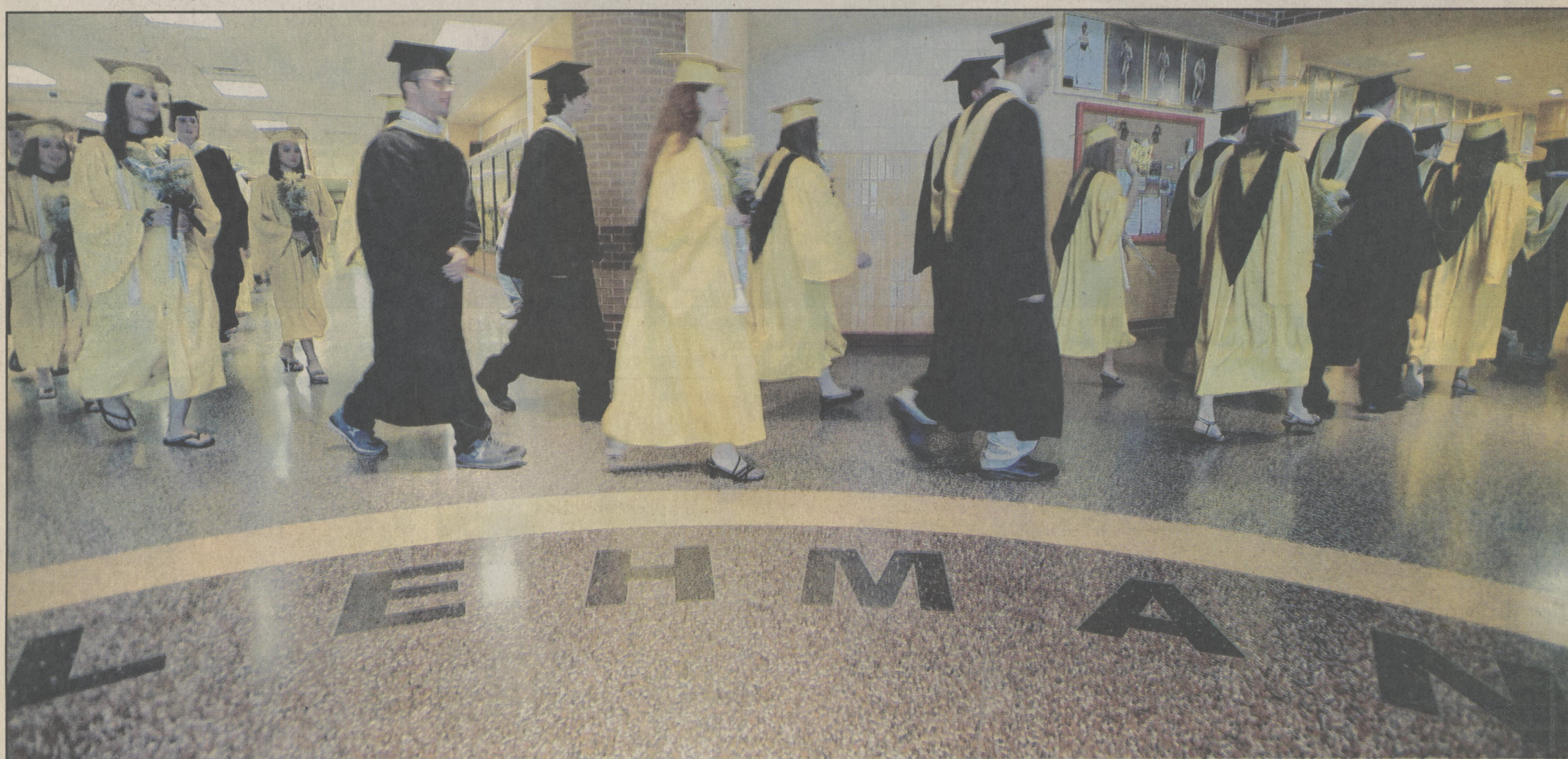




Jessica Alba fixes classmate Chris Barbacci's gown.
