Matt Labashosky and Chris

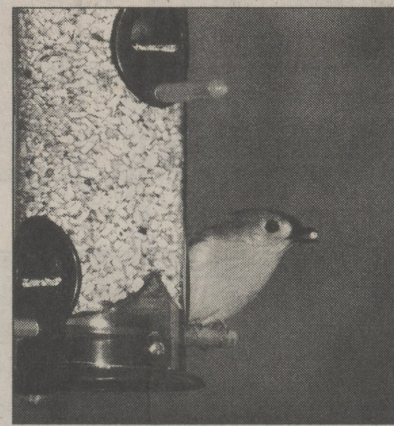
McCue both went 2-for-3 with a double to lead Kingston's effort.

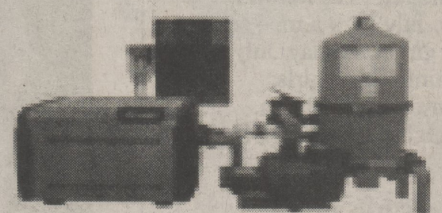
