Farmers return to market at library

The Back Mountain Farmers' Market begins Saturday, July 19, on the Back Mountain Memorial Library grounds, Huntsville Road, Dallas, and will be open from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. every Saturday through September 27.

Local favorites returning to the Back Mountain Farmers' Market this year are Golomb's Farm and Greenhouse, Dymond's Farm and Farm Markets, Brace's Orchard and Bakery, iGourmet.com, Creekside Farm and Nursery and Emma's Bakery. Market patrons will find

locally-grown seasonal fruits and vegetables, homemade baked goods, gourmet international cheeses and more.

New additions to the market this year are the "Soup Chic" offering homemade soups, salads and sandwiches, and Penn State's Master Gardener's Program, scheduled to share gardening and local agricultural expertise on July 26, August 16 and September 13.

To help "keep it green" in the Back Mountain, 100% cotton canvas "Back Mountain Farmers' Market" shop-

ping bags are now available for purchase at the library reception desk for only \$3 each. Bags will also be available at the market.

Vendors' stalls will be set up on the pavement of the library parking lot. Patrons are asked to park on the lawn behind the library (no neighborhood street parking).
