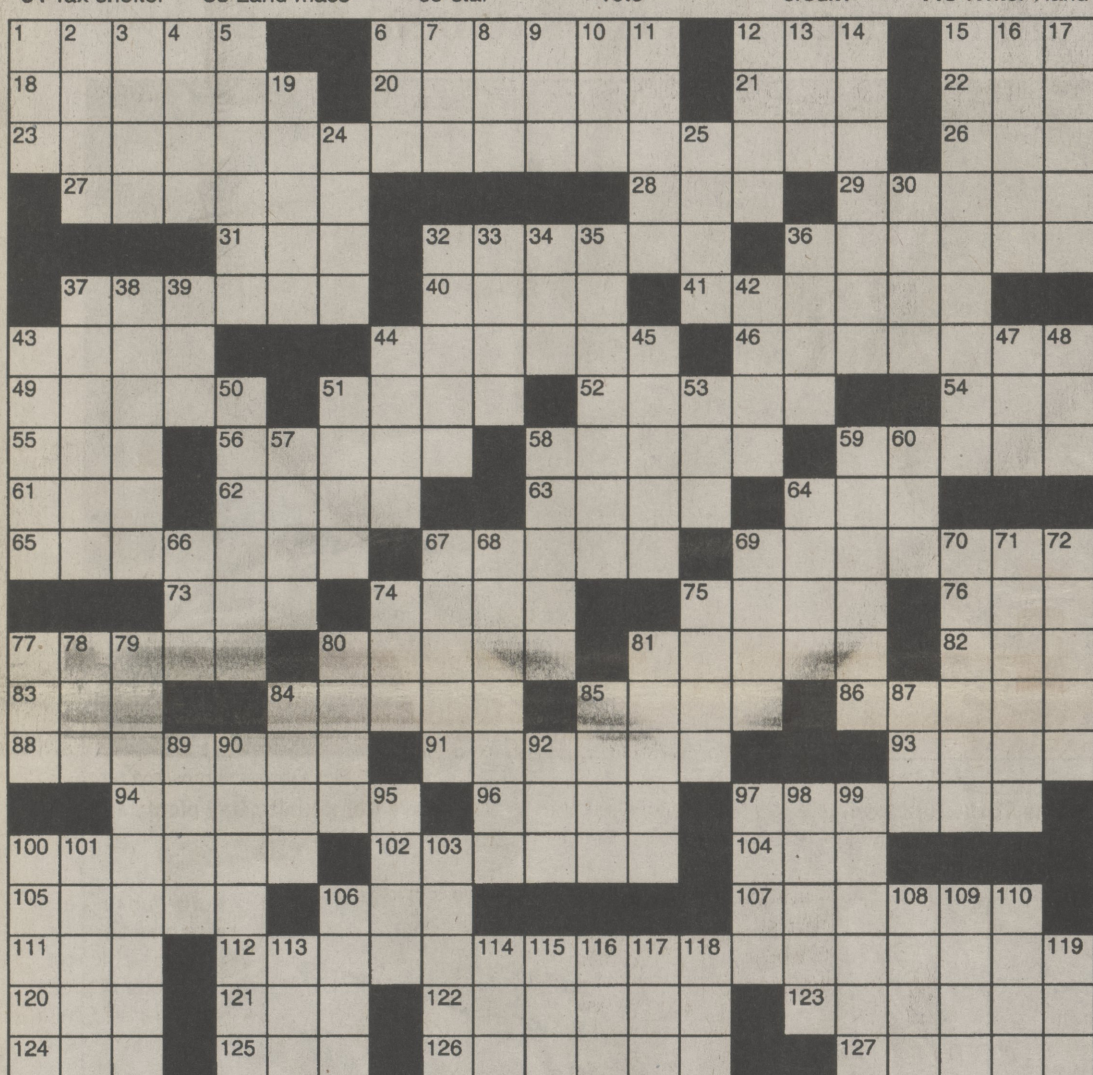

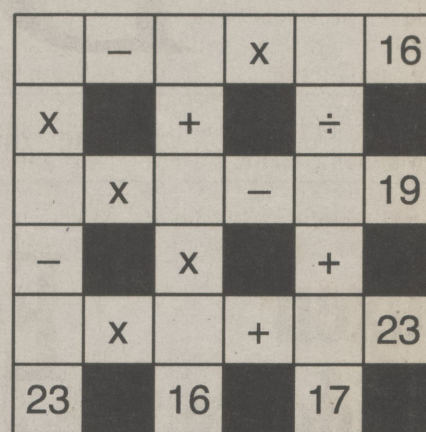

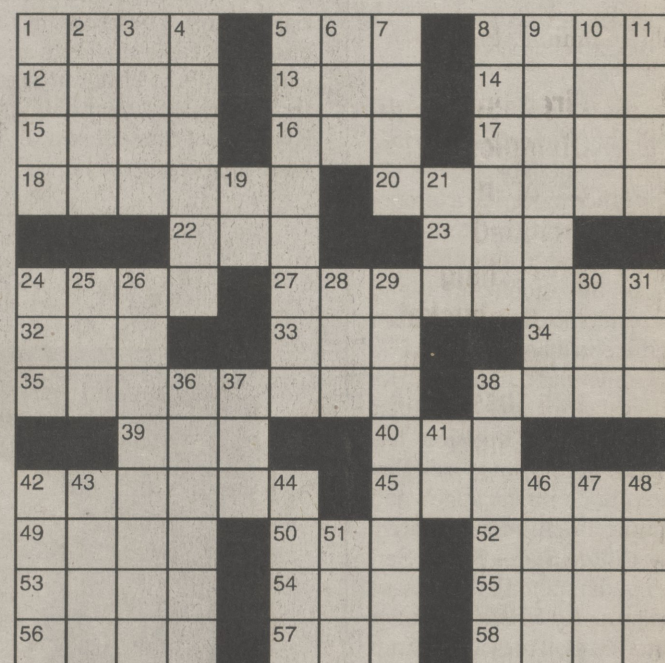

St. Paul's Evangelical Lutheran Church, Route 118, Dallas, will hold an "All That Jazz"

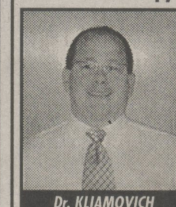
Summer Celebration/Live Auction on Saturday, Aug. 16, starting at 10 a.m. Auction bidding will begin at 6:30 p.m.
