There will be early dismissals on Friday, Oct. 31. The high school will be dismissed at 11:45 a.m. and the elementary schools will be dismissed at noon.

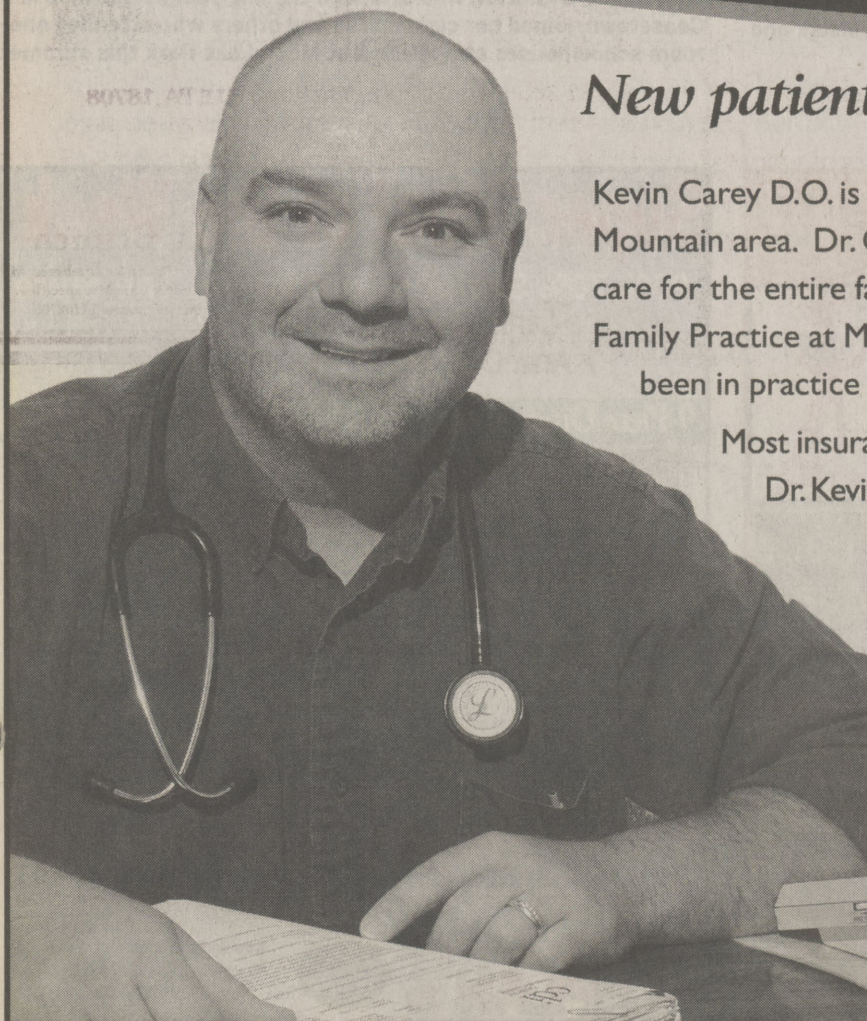
Old Shoe Game
