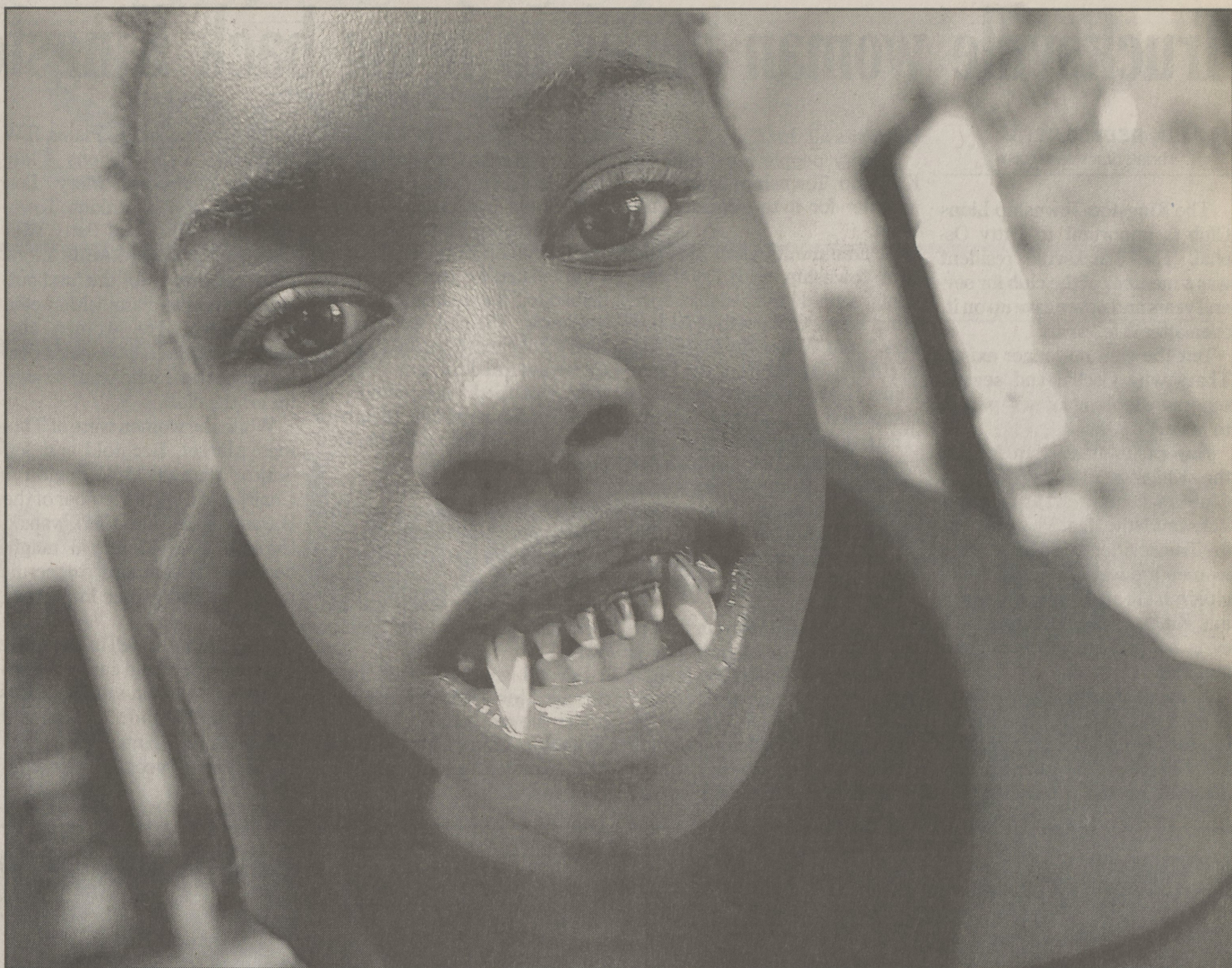


Costume variety
