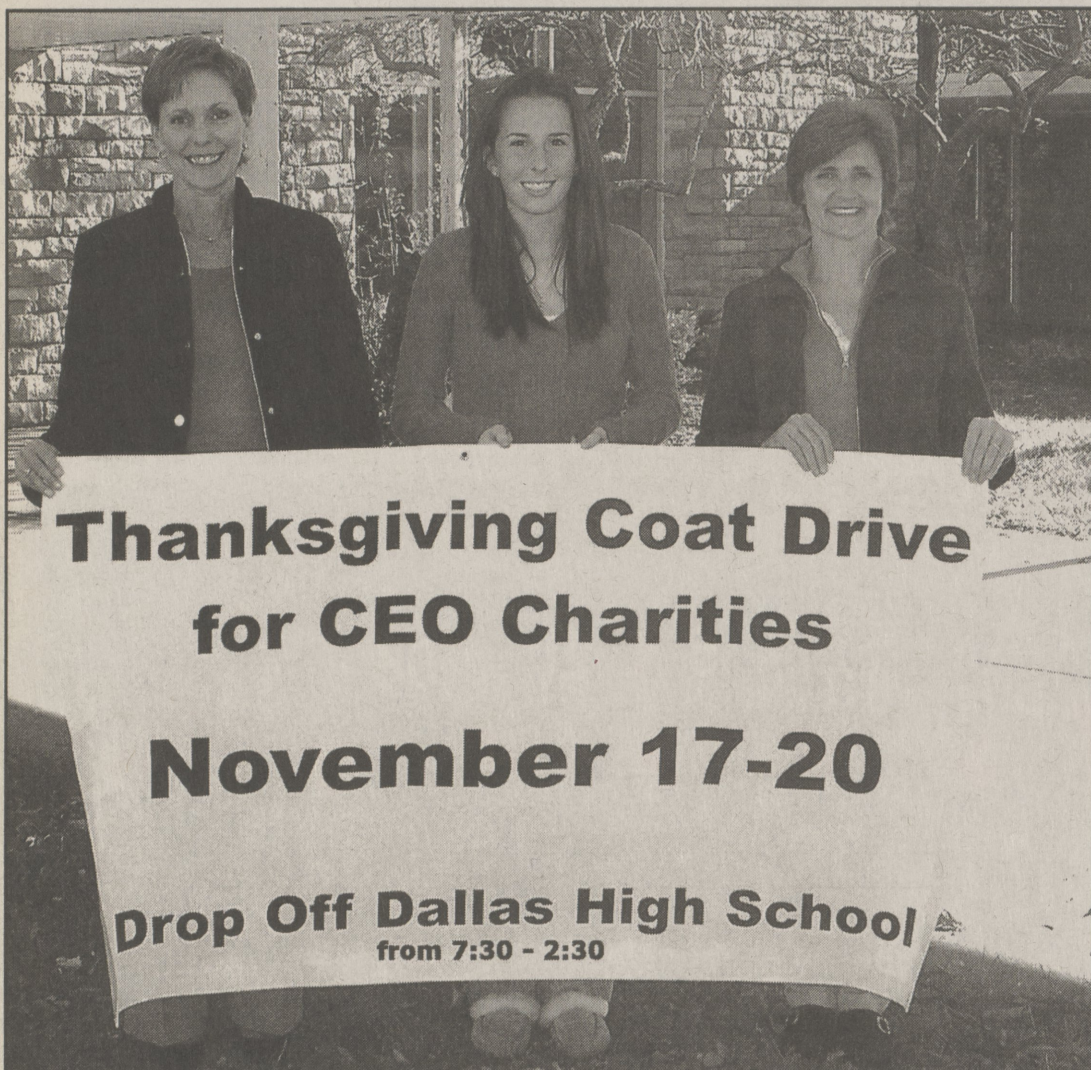


DHS COAT DRIVE STARTS TOMORROW

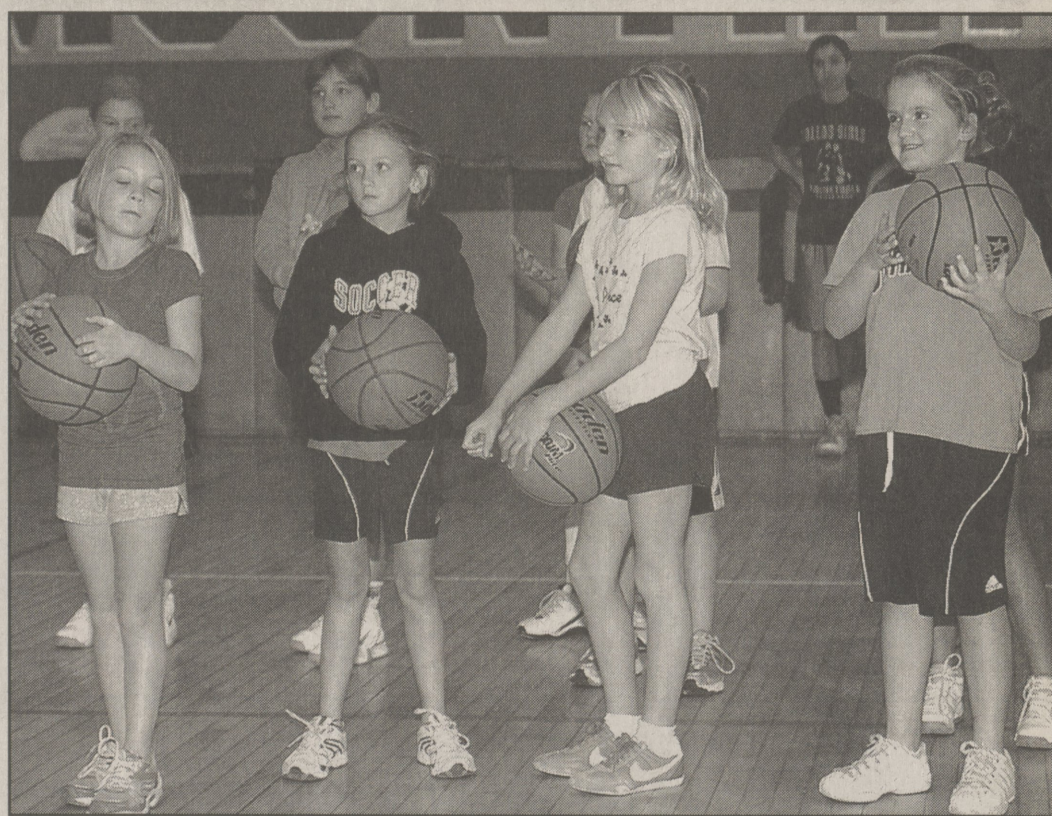
