The Red Cross requests that all donors bring identification and their Red Cross blood cards. Firsttime donors will receive a card after their first donation.


Anyone 17 years of age, weighing a minimum of 110 pounds and in good health is eligible to donate. Youths 16 years of age accompanied by a parent may also donate.


