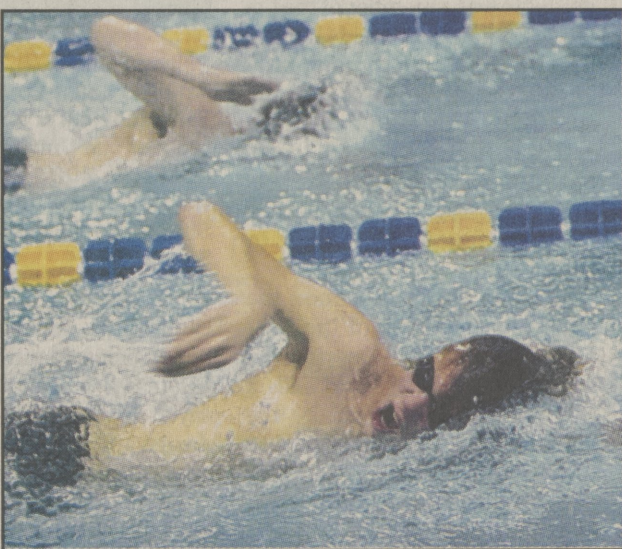
Ryan Zapoticky was high scorer for Medico with 15. Buddy Shutlock added eight while Steve Wempa played well, scoring eight.
