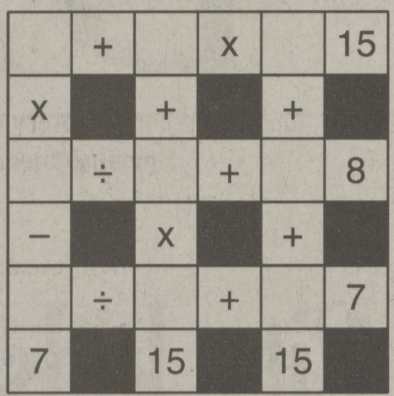

'Go Joe XII' makes Monday stop at Harveys Lake Beach Club

Joe Snedeker, weather forecaster for WNEP-TV, will embark on his annual bike ride to benefit St. Joseph's Center on Monday, July 20, as he attempts to ride more than 100 miles in a week. Joe will start his trek from the top of Elk Mountain in Susquehanna County and mountain bike down 1,000 feet in elevation before making his way through Clarks Summit and south on Route 92 to West Pittston. He picks up Route 11 before entering Route 309. "Go Joe XII" will make its way on Route 309 north through Trucksville, Shavertown and Dallas before turning onto route 415 on its way to

Harveys Lake. The Harveys Lake Beach Club will be open to the public from 1 to 8 p.m. with activities for the "Go Joe Bike Tour" and a live news report will be broadcast from the beach club between 5 and 7:30 p.m. Joe will begin the second day of his tour on Tuesday, July 21, when he departs from the Dallas Shopping Center and travels to Huntville and Chase before turning onto Route 29 in West Nanticoke. He will make a live stop at the Lycoming County Fair in Hughsville on Tuesday evening. He departs Wednesday morning from downtown Montoursville, making a live stop at

Schuylkill Haven's Bubeck Park Wednesday evening. On Thursday morning, the ride leaves from Schuylkill Haven and ends at the Freeland Public Park on Thursday evening. The tour leaves from White

Haven on Friday morning and ends at Hawley Bingham Park. The ride ends between 7 and 10 p.m. on Saturday, July 25, when Joe arrives at the St. Joseph's Festival at Marywood University where a live WNEP-TV broadcast welcomes him.
